Frankreich / France

Frankreich gilt als das Weinland, und entsprechend groß ist auch sein Einfluss. Die Topografie, seine regional typischen Rebsorten sowie der Stolz auf die Traditionen tragen dazu bei jährlich große Gewächse zu erzeugen. Bekannte Rebsorten sind: Pinot Blanc, Cabernet Franc, Pinot Noir. Bekannte Anbaugebiete sind: Elsass, Bordeaux, Loire, Pomerol, Bourgogne.

France is being considered as the wine-country, resulting in the great influence of it's products. The topography, the regional grape varieties as well as pride and tradition contribute to producing great wines every year. Well known grapes are: Pinot Blanc, Cabernet Franc, and Pinot Noir. Well known wine regions are: Alsace, Bordeaux, Loire, Pomerol, and Bourgogne.

Italien / Italy

Deutschland / Germany

Durch das milde Klima unterliegen die Trauben einer längeren Reifezeit als in südlichen Ländern. Die längere Reifeperiode lässt Geschmacksstoffe sowie Tannine entstehen, die dem deutschen Wein seine Qualität verleihen. Bekannte Rebsorten sind: Müller-Thurgau, Riesling, Spätburgunder, Silvaner. Bekannte Anbaugebiete sind: Baden, Pfalz, Rheingau, Rheinhessen, Franken, Ahr.

Because of the mild climate in Germany, the grapes are subject to longer adolescence than in southern countries. This results in special distinct flavors and tannins, which gives superior quality to German wines. Well known grapes are: Müller-Thurgau, Riesling, Spätburgunder, Silvaner. Well known wine regions are: Baden Pfalz, Rheingau, Rheinhessen, Franken, Ahr.

Österreich / Austria

Zu den bekanntesten Rebsorten zählen Grüner Veltliner, Blaufränkisch und Zweigelt. Österreich erzeugt große Qualitäten, wovon 2/3 QBA Weine sind, die einen internationalen Ruf genießen.

Bekannte Rebsorten sind: Gelber Muskateller, Grüner Veltliner, Blauer Zweigelt.

Bekannte Anbaugebiete sind: Wagram, Langlois, Kremstal.

Neuseeland / New Zealand

Sake

In der Herstellung ursprünglich dem japanischen Kaiserhof und Klöstern vorbehalten, wird Sake heute in international anerkannten Top-Qualitäten hergestellt und als Aperitif, zum Essen oder als Digestif gereicht.

Originally made only at the emperor's court and later in monasteries, today's sake is of internationally recognized top-quality and is being served as an

aperitif, during the meal or as a digestif.

Shochu

Ein im Gegensatz zu Sake *destilliertes* hochprozentiges Getränk, das seinen Ursprung in Kagoshima auf der Insel Kyushu hat. Shochu kann aus Reis („Kome Shochu“), Süßkartoffeln („Imo Shochu“), oder Zuckerrohr („Kokuto Shochu“) gewonnen werden. Bei Shiso Shochu handelt es sich um einen mit den Blättern der Schwarznessel aromatisierten Shochu.

In contrary to sake a high in alcohol content distilled beverage, which has its origin in Kagoshima on the isle of Kyushu.

Shochu can be distilled from rice (“Kome Shochu“), sweet potatoes (“Imo Shochu“), or sugar cane (“Kokuto Shochu“).

Shiso Shochu is a with the leaves of black horehound (“Shiso”) flavored Shochu.

The 1999 Lafite Rothschild sports an engraved "1999" on the bottle along with an eclipse to mark that significant historical event of August, 1999. It is a quintessential offering from Lafite Rothschild. This prodigious wine is both elegant and intensely flavoured, and almost diaphanous in its layers that unfold with no heaviness. An opaque ruby/purple colour is accompanied by a complex bouquet of lead pencil, graphite, cedar, crème de cassis, toast, and vanilla. It is medium-bodied, with extravagant layers of richness yet little weight, and a finish that is all sweetness, ripeness, and harmony. This extraordinary Lafite increasingly appears to be a modern day clone of the majestic 1953.

The 1995 Lafite-Rothschild (only one-third of the harvest made it into the final blend) is a blend of 75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 17% Merlot, and 8% Cabernet Franc. It exhibits a dark ruby purple colour, and a sweet, powdered mineral, smoky, weedy cassis-scented nose. Beautiful sweetness of fruit is present in this medium-bodied, tightly-knit, but gloriously pure, well-delineated Lafite.

The 1995 is not as powerful or as massive as the 1996, but it is beautifully made with outstanding credentials, in addition to remarkable promise.
